

If you arrive in Buenos Aires, Ezeiza International to the airport, there are two ways to get to Bahía Blanca:

- (1) **By plane.** In this case you should move to Jorge Newbery Airport and there take the flight to the city of Bahía Blanca. We recommend using the bus company Manuel Tienda León, which will take you directly to Jorge Newbery Airport. Manuel Tienda León has offices at the airport where you can buy your ticket or you can do so via the Internet.

The taxi fare between airports is about 170 pesos.

- (2) **By bus.** Should be moved to Retiro Bus Terminal, where you can take a service to the city of Bahía Blanca. Normally the trip takes between 8 and 10 hours. We recommend a night service with sleeping seats. The transfer from Ezeiza International Airport to Terminal Retiro can be done by Manuel Tienda León. It which leaves you in the Terminal Maderos, near the Retiro Terminal. Between the two terminals, the cost of a taxi does not exceed 20 pesos.
